VERTEX NEWS

The annual Vertex Foundation Scholarship Program is open! The scholarship helps people with cystic fibrosis (CF) and their families (siblings, caregivers, and children) in pursuing two-year, three-year, four-year, or graduate degrees to offset some of the costs of attending college or graduate school.

BILL SB844

Advocate for SB 844 - legislation to ensure all copays count!

Unfortunately, an increasing number of health insurers have implemented copay accumulator adjustment programs that ban copay assistance from counting towards patients' deductibles and out-of-pocket maximums. The insurer continues to collect the copay assistance, but once it runs out, patients are still required to pay the full deductible. 80% of Missouri marketplace plans include copay accumulator adjustment language. When copay assistance doesn't count, many patients cannot afford their treatments and stop taking them or reduce dosage. This often leads to unintended consequences such as increased emergency visits, hospital stays and missed days from work/school that harm patients and increase overall healthcare costs.

House Bill 1628/ Senate Bill 844 will help patients access critical treatment by ensuring all
